


## MAINTAINING OHIO'S VOTER RECORDS MEANS MORE VOTES ARE COUNTED

**7,861,465** registered voters

 More than **450,000** voters have updated their registration online


 Removed more than **520,000** deceased Ohioans from voter rolls



Since Secretary Husted took office, more provisional and absentee ballots have been counted and less provisional ballots have been cast.



Complete info (SS/DOB/DL) on **90%** of voters, up from 20% in 2011



Contacted about **1.5 million** voters to update info by mail

Contacted more than **1.65 million** Ohioans who are unregistered but eligible to vote



Resolved more than **1.5 million** duplicate registrations since 2011



## EVERY VOTE MATTERS

**109 elections** have been decided by **one vote or tied** in the last three years

## EASY TO VOTE AND HARD TO CHEAT



In the 2016 Presidential Election, Ohio voters have a month to cast a ballot, including:

**24/7** by-mail voting • **200+** hours for in-person voting including **13** hours on Election Day • **2** Saturdays and **2** Sundays

\*All eligible voters to receive personalized absentee ballot application

To date, Ohio has received over **6,800** Federal Post Card Applications from military and overseas voters in **48** states, **101** countries and **9** Navy ships



Secretary Husted has compiled two statewide voter fraud and suppression reports uncovering:

**284** voter fraud cases

**0** voter suppression cases

**436** non-citizens registered

**44** non-citizens whom cast ballots



## PREPARING FOR A SMOOTH ELECTION



Recruited more than **15,900** poll workers since April 2012 and distributed nearly **\$2.3 million** in training funds from 2011-2016.

Nearly **\$340,000** has been awarded for **98** projects around Ohio to improve access at the polls.



## SERVING BUSINESSES IN OHIO

### OCTOBER 2013



Ohio Business Central launched, now 82% of filings can be done online, 1 in 2 companies are started online & 179,742 businesses have been started online

### SEPTEMBER 2015



Cost of starting a new business cut by 21% to \$99, making Ohio the cheapest state in the region to start and maintain a business. To date, entrepreneurs have saved an estimated \$2.3 million due to the cost reduction in filing fees.

### 2015



97,746 entities filed, up from 93,775 in 2014, a new 5-year record.

### JANUARY 2016

Cleveland Sight Center takes over operation of business services call center.



### SEPTEMBER 2016

9,671 businesses filed, up from 8,003 in September 2015. To date, over 5,100 more entities have filed in 2016 compared to same time in 2015.
