Dear Secretary Brunner:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 3519.01(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, a written petition proposing a Constitutional Amendment to add Section 21 to Article I of the Ohio Constitution was submitted for my examination, together with a summary of that initiated amendment. Pursuant to my statutory duties, I considered the language of both the proposed amendment and the summary of the proposed amendment appearing on the petition, and certified that the summary is a fair and truthful statement of the measure to be proposed.

In accordance with my determination, on April 1, 2010, I forwarded the proposal to you in your capacity as Chair of the Ballot Board for consideration in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 3505.062. Enclosed please find a copy of my certification letters dated April 1, 2010.

As a result of today's Ballot Board meeting, the Board certified that the proposed petition contains one issue. Pursuant to the Ohio Ballot Board's certified approval and Ohio Revised Code Section 3519.01(A), I am now filing with you a verified copy of the proposed amendment, its summary, and a copy of my letters certifying that the summary is a fair and truthful statement of the proposed initiated Constitutional Amendment to Article I. For your convenience, I am also attaching a copy of the Ohio Ballot Board's letter certifying that the petition contains only one proposed issue.
