Shall an annual income tax of 1% on the earned income of individuals residing in the school district, be imposed for 5 years, beginning 1/1/2009, for current expenses & permanent improvements?

<i>Proposed School Income Tax - Garfield Heights City School District</i>	420	2,470
Shall an annual income tax of 1% on the earned income of individuals residing in the school district be imposed, for cpt, beginning 1/1/2009, to current expenses, be approved?		
<b>DELAWARE COUNTY</b>		
<b>Proposed Municipal Income Tax - Delaware City</b>	<b>2,307</b>	2,191
Shall Ordinance 08-29 providing for 0.15% increase of the existing city income tax to improve the municipal recreation facilities, including the construction of a recreation center to provide fitness, track swimming & indoor/outdoor multi-purpose facilities & athletic fields & to construct, renovate & improve other municipal recreation facilities, including providing furnishings & equipment for the center & all of such other facilities, and to acquire related interests in real property & otherwise improve the same, together with all necessary appurtenances thereto & pay the debt service charges & related costs of securities issued to pay the costs of the center & other facilities; and shall be placed in a special fund or funds & used only for that purpose, all until December 31, in the calendar year in which all securities issued for this purpose are retired, beginning 1/1/2009m be passed?
