You can serve as a P.E.O. in Ohio if you:

- Are a U.S. citizen
- Are at least 18 years of age and registered to vote
- Are a resident of the county in which you plan to serve
- Are not running as a candidate for the election in which you are working
- Have not been convicted of a felony

Keep in mind:

- All P.E.O.s are required to attend a training session scheduled by their county board of elections prior to the election.
- You can expect to work from about 5:30 a.m. (polls are open at 6:30) until 8:30 p.m. (polls close at 7:30), though working hours vary from county to county.


