DELAWARE COUNTY

Buckeye Valley Local School District - (Delaware*, Marion, Morrow, Union) Income Tax & Bond Issue

Shall the Buckeye Valley Local School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Impose an annual income tax of 0.25% on the school district for 5 years, beginning 1/1/2013, for current operating expenses of the school district -
- 2) Issue bonds to construct school facilities, including an elementary school & renovating existing school facilities; to furnish and equip the same; to improve the sites thereof & acquire land and interests in land in the principal amount of \$30,000,000, which amounts to 3.5 mills, for 28 years?

SUMMIT COUNTY

Coventry Local School District - Bond Issue & Tax Levy

Shall the Coventry Local School District be authorized to do the following:

- 1) Issue bonds for the purpose of constructing, renovating, remodeling, rehabilitating, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving school district buildings and facilities, preparing and improving their sites, and acquiring real estate, buildings & facilities and interests therein, for school district purposes, in the principal amount of \$28,308,500, which amounts to 4.89 mills, for 34 years -
- 2) Levy an additional property tax of 1.1 mill, for a cpt, to acquire, construct, enlarge, renovate & finance permanent improvements?

Edon Northwest Local School District - Income Tax & Tax Levy

- 1) Impose an annual income tax of 0.5% on the school district, for 3 years, beginning 1/1/2013, to provide for the current expenses of the school district -
- 2) Levy an additional property tax of 3.7 mills, to provide for the necessary requirements of the school district, for 3 years, commencing in 2012, first due in calendar year 2013?
