

PETITIONER STATEMENT

Revised Code Sections 4301.331

To be filed no later than 4 p.m., 90 days before the day of the next primary or general election with a certified copy of the judgment entry with the board of elections of the county in which the nuisance was adjudged to exist.

NOTE: Failure of the petitioner to supply a complete and accurate address as stated in R.C. 4301.331 to the board of elections invalidates the election.
