Dear nonprofit/volunteer/school boosters,

While few fundraising events are happening this year, from boosters selling hot dogs at high school football games to signature tents at the Ohio State Fair, nonprofits are struggling to raise both awareness and funds. This Election Day, a unique call is going out to young, healthy Ohioans to be poll workers. Many are donating their \$100+ poll worker pay to a charity of their choice.

Poll workers are essential to running elections. Ohio's 88 county Boards of Elections have historically relied on over 35,000 patriotic Ohioans to operate voting locations and assist fellow voters with casting a ballot. With more than 65% of Ohio poll workers being age 61 or over, there is a concern that many may choose not to serve this November due to the disproportionate impact of COVID-19 on older populations.

By encouraging volunteers to be poll workers, nonprofits can inspire citizens to defend democracy by helping those in their community to make their voice heard. Their poll worker pay will then be donated to the nonprofit to further another important mission in one fell swoop.

Spread the word far and wide to not only defend democracy this fall, but support another cause that you believe in.
