Dear Ohioan,

As Ohio's Chief Elections Officer, I want every eligible Ohioan to participate in our elections, and that's why I'm sending you this personal invitation to once again become a registered voter.

Unfortunately, the voter registration associated with this address hasn't participated in any election that has taken place in the past six years or updated their voter registration information during that time. Under Ohio law, that means your local county Board of Elections was required to cancel that voter registration.

This is your chance for a fresh start. This is your chance to register to vote and have your voice heard.

The process is simple. You can either register online at MyOhioVote.com/FreshStart, or use the registration form enclosed in this mailing.

Instructions on how to mail your registration form can be found on the back of this letter.

Voting is one of the most important rights and responsibilities we have as U.S. citizens, and the choices we make at the ballot box matter. We want you to be an Ohio voter.

How to Seal and Mail Your Voter Registration Form

The United States Postal Service recommends taking the following steps to make sure your Voter Registration Form is delivered to the Ohio Secretary of State's Office:

1. Fold your Voter Registration Form in half along the dotted line with the Secretary of State's address facing outwards.
2. Take two pieces of clear tape and fold each over the leading and trailing edge of the form to seal. Place the cut side of each piece along the guides on the edge of the Voter Registration Form. **PLEASE NOTE:** tape closures cannot overlap the postage.
3. Place a first-class stamp on the marked location.
4. Put your properly folded and sealed Voter Registration Form in the mail.
