What is Happening?

Both state and federal law require Ohio to maintain accurate voter records. Your county board of elections has identified your voter registration as being inactive for at least six years. To continue as an active voter, you must take one of the following actions outlined below.

What can you do to remain registered to vote in Ohio?

- Respond to the postcard mailed by your county board of elections.
- Update your registration information on VoteOhio.gov.
- Mail in a voter registration form that can be found at your local board of elections, public library, BMV or elsewhere.

Your registration will be cancelled if you do not take action by September 6th. However, if the registration is cancelled, you may still re-register to vote up to 30 days prior to the upcoming election. The voter registration deadline for the November 5, 2019 election is October 7, 2019.
