WHICH VOTING OPTION WORKS BEST FOR YOU

ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL:

Vote from the comfort of home by requesting that your ballot be mailed to you.

Simply complete it and either:

- Drop it off at your local board of elections, or
- Return it by mail.

No need to stand in line.

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING:

During the absentee period, you may vote in person at your local county board of elections or designated early voting center. Uniform voting hours have been set to serve all voters no matter where they live, including on some weekend days.

Check with your county board of elections for additional times and locations.

ON ELECTION DAY:

Polls are open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Find your polling location at www.MyOhioVote.com and don't forget to bring your ID.
